# 1. Tested product

We tested IKARUS virus.utilities T3 from the Austrian-based IKARUS Security Software GmbH vendor (www.ikarus.at), with last signature update and version of the 26<sup>th</sup> March 2008 under Windows XP SP2. The used test-set is from the 4<sup>th</sup> February 2008 and contains nearly 1,7 million malware samples.

# 2. Test results


Below the on-demand detection rates of IKARUS virus.utilities T3:

Windows viruses	96,8%
Macro viruses	97,9%
Script viruses/malware	90,5%
Worms	97,4%
Backdoors	99,1%
Trojans	96,5%
Other malware	91,7%

### TOTAL detection rate: 97,3%

Considering that the product was tested over a nearly 2 month old total detection rate of test-set, with a 97,3%, virus.utilities T3 would in our regular tests (with up-to-date testset) probably reach the ADVANCED certification level.

IKARUS virus.utilities T3 is not certified by WestCoastLabs and/or ICSALabs and has recently not passed the VirusBulletin tests (mainly due the relativly high amount of false alarms).
